

Loutra Pozar and Edessa

Edessa Waterfalls were initially created by the late 14th century where the main volume of water retained in a small area west of the city. Then the water decides to cross the city and leak, jumped from the rock of consistently creating many small rivers.

Pozar (Loutraki). Spread in the foothills of Mount Kaimaktsalan. The spa, hot water with constant temperature of 37oC, springs for thousands of years from the mountain, which creates a stunning landscape of mountain and forest. Visitors arriving at the Spa from every corner of Greece to accept the beneficial properties of hot water (treatment - relaxing), and/or to escape to the beautiful mountains, caves.

Private baths operate also in the premises for someone seeking private comfort.

The canyon stretches from the Greek border to the Baths, in a uniquely beautiful area, rich in wildlife and unspoiled vegetation and waterfalls. Paved paths, benches and streets, running parallel mixing of hot and cold water. A beautiful and relaxing trip to the nature.
