



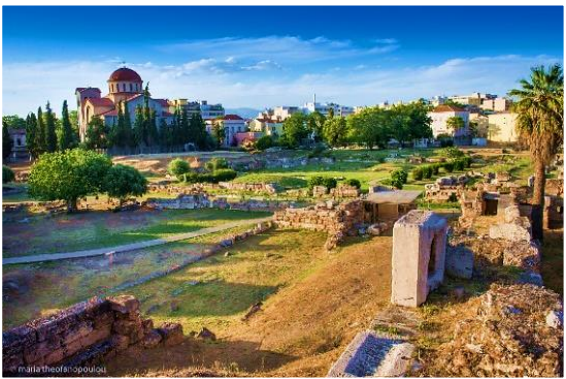

Sophisticated Tour



Day 01 Athens Arrival

Welcome to Athens!! Meet at the airport our friendly representative and transfer directly to the city center by 40-seater bus to start your tour.



Travel back to the days of Ancient Greece on a 2-hour guided tour of Athens Acropolis. Climb to the Parthenon, the summit of the city. Enjoy panoramic views across the remains of the classical world and modern-day city of Athens.

Then, continue to Kerameikos Archaeological Site (museum included) and its mystic charm which was the city's ancient cemetery dating back to ancient times. You will also notice the ancient city walls as well as the Dipylon Gate and the Sacred Gate. Great processions - during the city's major religious festivals - have passed through these gates on the way to the Acropolis and the sanctuary of Eleusis.

Continue to the West of Athens to reach Eleusis (museum included). The Eleusinian Mysteries performed every year in the honor of the goddess Dimitra and her daughter Persephone. Nowadays, in the archaeological site of Eleusis you will admire the Roman courtyard where is the temple of Artemis Propylaea, the remains of a fountain and two triumphal arches. Then you will enter to the precincts of the sanctuary of Greater Propylaea, next to which is preserved the Kallichoro Frear. Then passes from the Lesser Propylaea, having on the right the cave Ploutoneio and reaches the main temple of Demeter the Telesterion.

Transfer to your hotel where there is time, after dinner, to settle in and relax.





Day 02 Argolis Tour

After breakfast, explore with this guided full day trip from Athens to Argolis the remains of the ancient city of Mycenae a major center of Greek civilization from 1600BC to 1100BC and a world heritage monument. Depart from our terminal for one-day tour via the coastal National highway for the Corinth canal (short stop).

After the Corinth Canal, visit the archaeological site of **Nemea**, where a top local event has been taking place for the last twenty-odd years: this is the revival of 'Nemeia' i.e. the sports games that used to take place in ancient Nemea since 573 BC and every two years in turns with the Olympic Games and the games in Delphi and Isthmia. The Modern Nemeia Games were revived in 1996, 2300 years later, and they take place every four years, with participating athletes and spectators from across the world. Time will then be taken for a traditional Greek optional lunch at a nearby restaurant.

Then, you enter the region of Argolis, land of Homer's Golden **Mycenae**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Dating back to the second century B.C., Mycenae was one of the major centers of Greek civilization and a military stronghold which dominated much of southern Greece. Visit the archaeological site, home to the kingdom of mythical Agamemnon. You will see the Cyclopean Walls, the Lion's Gate, the Royal Tombs, including Agamemnon Clytemnestra's, and the Treasury of Atreus, a magnificent 14th-century B.C. structure.

Continue on to **Epidaurus** and **Sanctuary of Asclepius**. Visit the ancient theatre, the UNESCO'S world heritage listed monument is reputed to be the birthplace of Apollo's son Asclepius, the healer and was the most celebrated healing center of the classical world. Return late afternoon to hotel for dinner.





Day 03 Sail to Mykonos

Prepare your luggage and after breakfast get on the bus to Rafina Port. Arrive to Mykonos by ferry boat. Transfer to your hotel, relax and enjoy the sea the rest of the day! Have your dinner in hotel's restaurant.

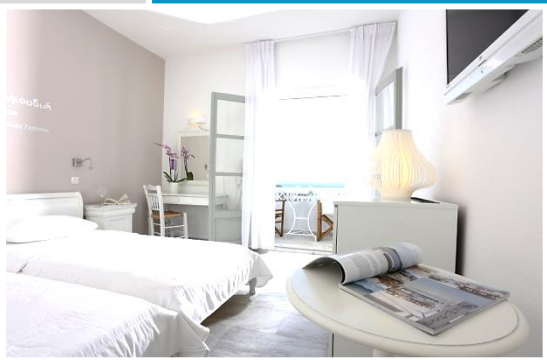
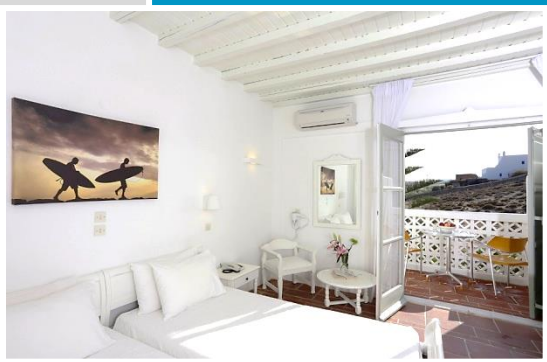
Day 04 Mykonos Delos Tour

Transfer to Mykonos port and start a half-day trip to the sacred island of Apollo and Artemis, a famous political and religious center in Antiquity.

The whole territory of the deserted Delos is one of the most important archaeological sites of the eastern Mediterranean protected by UNESCO as one of the UNESCO heritage sites of the world. You may visit, amongst others, the remains of the Temples of Apollo, the sanctuary of Artemis, the old city and the theatre and then, walk down the celebrated Lion Street.

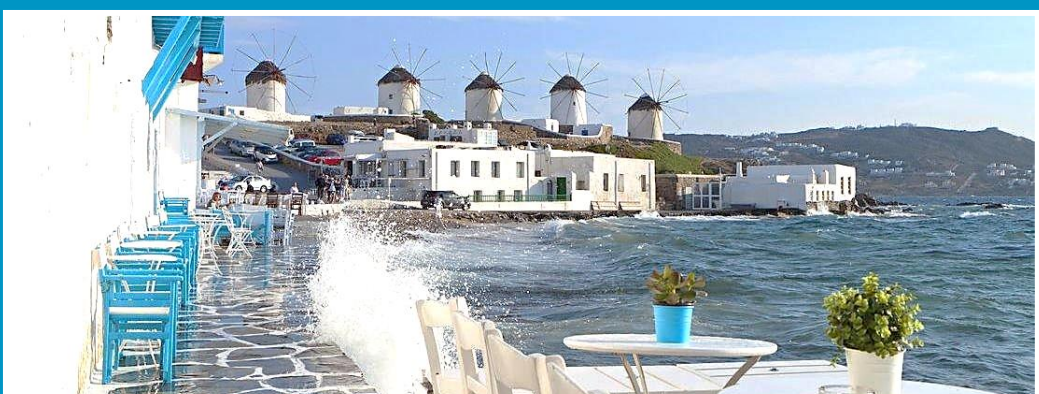
Also, in the museum of Delos, you can admire Archaic, Classical, Hellenistic and Roman Sculptures, a collection of vessels from all periods as well as small items of everyday use.

Return to Mykonos Island for an optional half day orientation tour of Mykonos on foot and return to your hotel for dinner.



Day 05 Sail back to Athens

It's time to return back to Athens. Transfer to the port and embark the ferry boat to Rafina's Port. Disembark from ferry boat and transfer to your hotel for check in and free day at leisure. Dinner at your hotel!



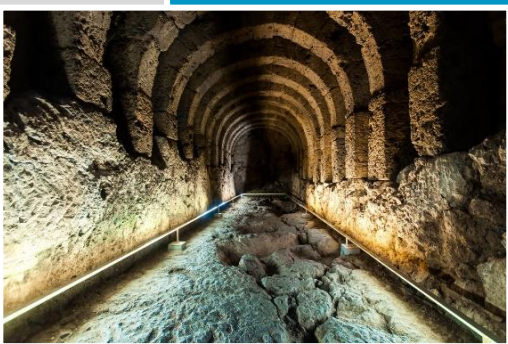


Day 06 Classical Tour to Delphi / Ioannina



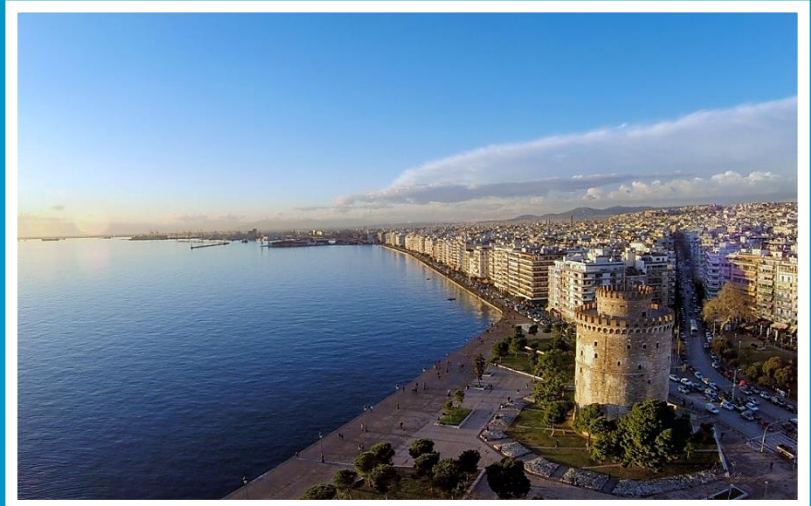
After breakfast pick up for a special day tour in Delphi. Upon arrival in Delphi you'll visit Castalia Spring and the main archaeological site the Temple of Apollo, the Treasury of the Athenians, the Theatre, the Stadium and the Museum with the famous statue of Antinoos and the unique bronze statue of the Charioteer. Enjoy a break for an optional lunch in town and then relax on your afternoon journey through central Greece. Gaze out of your window as you cross the beautiful places, passing the pretty towns of Nafpaktos, Amfilochia and Arta, and then arrive at your hotel. Dinner in your hotel and overnight stay at Ioannina.

Day 07 Classical Tour to Dodona & Acheron



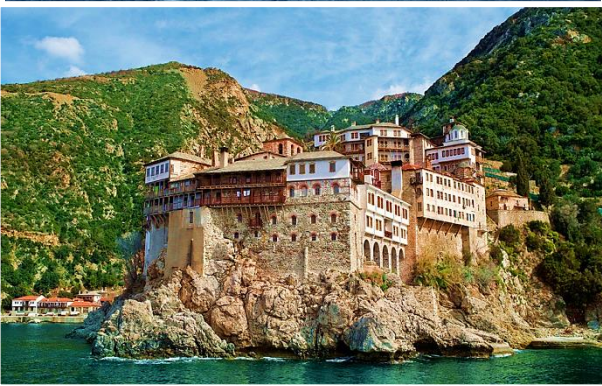
Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Dodoni. The tour starts at the Ancient Theatre of Dodoni, which was built in the third century. It is one of the largest and best preserved ancient Greek theatres and was able to fit about 18,000 spectators. After an optional lunch, you arrive in Gliko village (Acheron river springs) and you start the walking in the river for one and a half hour guided tour till the springs (optional, small cruise along the river and the cave of Persefoni on the coast or activities like Canoeing, Kayak, Horse riding). Following the tour, you are visiting the Nekromanteion, an ancient Greek temple of necromancy devoted to Hades and Persephone. Return to hotel for dinner.





Day 08 Classical Tour to Halkidiki

Full American Buffet Breakfast and leave directly for your route to Halkidiki. Check in your hotel, have your dinner and enjoy your sea view room!



Day 09 Athos Cruise

Transfer to Ouranoupolis after breakfast to start your cruise to Athos!

The whole experience of the cruise to Mount Athos is unique. For approximately 40 minutes until you come across the first monastery, the visitor can admire the miracle of nature that is untouched by the human hand. Unique beaches and wild beauty of green, mountain, ravines and steep cliffs. The first monastery you come across is the Monastery of Dochiariou and then the Monastery of Xenophontos, the Monastery of Panteleimon (Russian), the Monastery of Xeropotamou, Daphne (port), the Monastery of Simonopetra, the Monastery of Osiou Gregoriou, the Monastery of Dionysiou, the Monastery of St. Paul and the sketes, New Skete and Agia Anna. Return to Ouranoupolis for an optional lunch and then back to hotel.

Day 10 Thessaloniki Departure

Transfer to Thessaloniki's airport after breakfast.
